1) The 19th International Polish Championship will be held in Keystone from 03/29/17 till 03/31/17. Trophies of the Consulate General of Poland in Los Angeles, CA will be awarded to the six fastest athletes in Men's and Women's divisions. Slalom and Giant Slalom medals will be awarded through third place in each age group. Snowboarders will be awarded medals for Giant Slalom in the Men and Women categories.

2) To enter competitors must be Polish, or of Polish descent (this can include friends of Polish families). All competitors must register by completing and signing the application and paying registration fee.

3) Age of competitor counts by December 31st of the year preceding the competition. Competitors will be placed in the following age groups:

Girls	6-8	9-11	12-14									
Boys	6-8	9-11	12-14									
Women	15-24	25-34	35-44	45+								
Men	15-19	20-24	25-29	30-34	35-39	40-44	45-49	50-54	55-59	60-64	65+	

4) Each competitor is entitled to two runs per Slalom and Giant Slalom course. Snowboarders will compete only in the Giant Slalom competition. All medals will be handed out through 3rd place in the men and women categories.

5) The correct course route is to navigate between gates from start to finish with both skis.

6) Competitors for The Family Cup must be related to one other. This can include the father or mother with their child, two competitors married to one other, or two sibling's. For ranking, the score is counted four times the total sum of the runs: two Slalom and two Giant Slalom.

7) Anyone who is late to start will have to start at the end of their age group.

8) Time of course inspection included in the event program.

9) In the event of a conflict, immediately report to the Event Referees and pay the \$25 deposit. The deposit will be refunded if the complaint is justified, otherwise the deposit shall be forfeited.

12) The organizers reserve the right to change the rules, conduct of competition, or any appeals in the event of unforeseeable circumstances.
